"I ought to pray before seeing any one. Often when I sleep long, or meet with others early, it is eleven or twelve o'clock before I begin secret prayer. This is a wretched system. It is unscriptural. Christ arose before day and went into a solitary place. David says: 'Early will I seek thee'; "Thou shalt early hear my voice.' Family prayer loses much of its power and sweetness, and I can do no good to those who come to seek from me. The conscience feels guilty, the soul unfed, the lamp not trimmed. Then when in secret prayer the soul is often out of tune. I feel it is far better to begin with God-to see his face first, to get my soul near him before it is near another." (Robert Murray M'Cheyne)

Papa Roy says, Prayer must not be our chance work, but our daily business, our habit and vocation. As artists give themselves to their models, and poets to their classical pursuits, so must we addict ourselves to prayer. We must be immersed in prayer as in our element, and so pray without ceasing. Lord, teach us so to pray that we may be more and more prevalent in supplication. (Spurgeon)

It is speaking boldly to God. It is a private moment not likely spoken in a public place. We experienced also big earthquake that caused children afraid and crying for they never experienced it before, and through this, some buildings in our place damaged also and thank God we were safe. I know that month of August had many calamities not only in the Philippines but in some other countries also and these

already predicted in the Bible as the signs that we are in the end time.

Our Ministerial fellowship succeeds. We met different ministers from different places and different denomination throughout Surigao del Sur. Some politician visited and let them received the Lord and prayed.

The children in orphanage are now growing and need to have additional double deck beds which are bigger than the old beds and we trust God that He will make a way for the materials. We are now in a wet season which more rains until February. Another typhoon coming to Mindanao and we don't let the children go to school today due to so much rain. Our Pastors need more protection when going to the area due to the damaged and slippery roads. We have two outreaches which in need more prayers due to the works of New People's Army.
